The Incredible Years Autism for Teachers programme supports teachers to create the best learning environment for children aged two to five on the autism spectrum.

The Incredible Years Helping Children with Autism programme for teachers helps you to engage with children in ways that encourage emotional self-regulation and support their communication skills. You'll also learn to build their social skills and empathy, and help them form positive relationships. The programme uses evidence-based behaviour strategies you can use to develop and implement goals based on the developmental needs of the children you support. It is run over six half day sessions and is funded by the Ministry, including a contribution paid to centres or schools to help teachers participate.
