- Strengths are in Performing Arts, Audio Visual, Sport.


Definition of Bullying

- It is important that students have a clear definition of Bullying before you embark on any initiatives to reduce bullying:
- Bullying is deliberate and involves a power imbalance, actual or perceived, unequal relationship between target and initiator: size, age, gender, social status, digital capability and access.
- Bullying is repetitive over time with threats of further incidents.
- Bullying is harmful: short or long term physical or psychological harm.


Every Monday Morning we have a Values Assembly which has a set format and is taken by the Principal.

Each week there is a different value and a story containing a value is shown on the big screen for maximum impact. Teachers follow up the story back in the classroom with specific values teaching.




Youtube Clip >>>

The values story is followed by a Youtube clip which is anti-bully or Motivational. This is also followed up in the classroom.




Being an UPSTANDER not a BYSTANDER >>>

Our present focus for this term is to be an UPSTANDER not a BYSTANDER and we are encouraging kids to report inappropriate behaviour of any sort.





Roots of Empathy


Kaitao is in the fifth year of Roots of Empathy and this year we have three programmes operating.
